Bild rigging (or collusive bigiding) occurs when businesses, that would otherwise be expected to compete, secretly conspire to raise prices or tower the quality of goods and / or services for purchasers who wish to acquire goods and / or services through a bidding process. Aid rigging is, therefore, an agreement between competitors and to compete.
