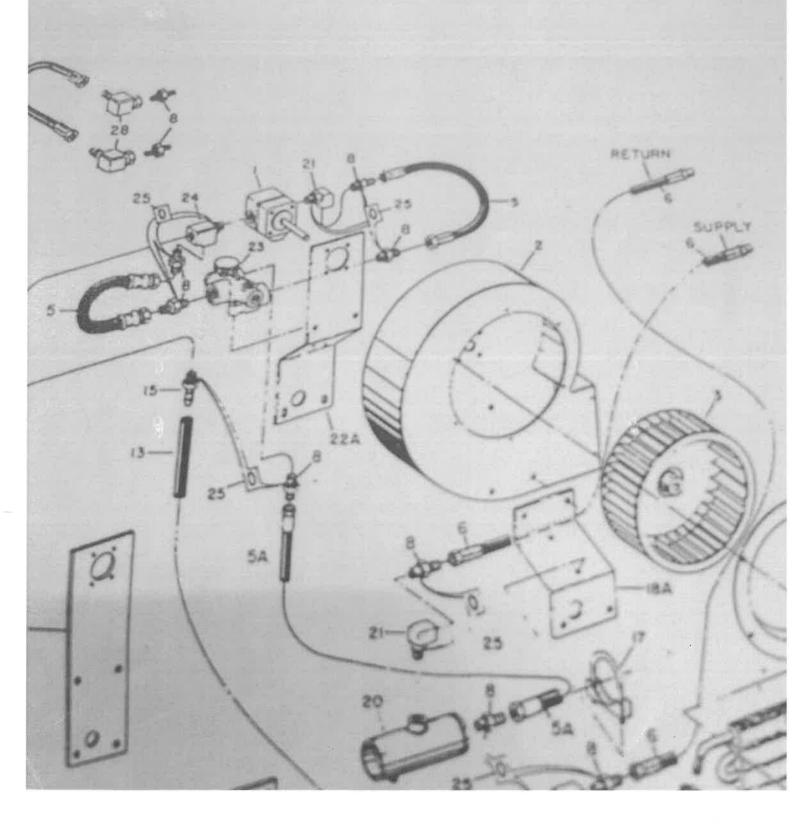

FIG. 1: Blower

1. Hydraulic Flow Control Valve

Air pressure is maintained by the blower to hold seed in the seed discs. Blower speed, regulated by the hydraulic flow control valve is directly related to pressure: Higher speed produces higher pressure.

Correct pressure is important:

- Too much pressure causes plant over-population.
- Too little pressure causes plant under-population.

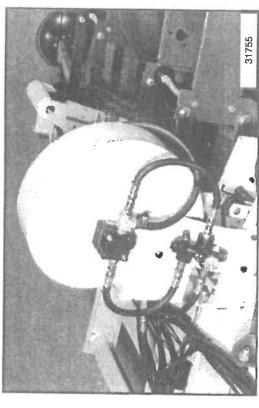

DECLARATION CERTIFICATE FOR LOCAL PRODUCTION AND CONTENT FOR DESIGNATED SECTORS

This Standard Bidding Document (SBD) must form part of all bids invited. It contains general information and serves as a declaration form for local content (local production and local content are used interchangeably).
