

# BUSINESS CONTINUITY PLAN IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS

### **FOR**

KZN DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT.

**MARCH 2020** 

#### **OVERVIEW**

The President of the Republic of South Africa has pronounced a lockdown on 23<sup>rd</sup> of March 2020 in response to an increase in transmission rate of coronavirus by South Africans. Lessons learnt from other countries showed that lockdown decreases transmission. The lockdown will commence from midnight of 26<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to the 16<sup>th</sup> of April 2020 i.e 21 days.

This pronouncement has significant implications on the department's ability to provide normal services to its clients hence a business continuity plan must be developed to ensure that operations are not halted completely.

The purpose of this plan is therefore to ensure that critical and essential services offered by the department continues during lockdown.

#### **COMPONENTS OF THE PLAN**

The following components are building blocks of our business continuity: -

- Activation of departmental crisis management committee;
- Identification of critical and essential services personnel;
- Measure taken to limit exposure and ensure protection of those identified staff members;
- Key staff members that will be operating from home;
- IT support required to enable continued operations; and
- Communication with staff during lockdown.

### a) ACTIVATION OF DEPARTMENTAL CRISIS MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE.

The MEC will spearhead the Departmental command centre whilst the HOD and DDG: RD will be ensuring the implementation of all decision taken at the command centre. The following members are part of a departmental crisis management committee:-

## 3) MESURES TAKEN TO ENSURE PROTECTION OF CRITICAL AND ESSENTIAL SERVICE STAFF MEMBERS FROM COVID-19 EXPOSURE.

- · Provision of individual sanitisers, masks and temperature monitoring device;
- Ensure that hand sanitizers are placed at strategic locations in all offices
   where critical and essential services staff operate from;
- Sterilise and disinfect all hard surfaces i.e door handles, desks, chairs, telephones on an hourly basis;
- Provide ongoing awareness programme through electronic medium;
- Ensure constant communication to receive feedback and disseminate information about the departmental response to this pandemic.

### 4) KEY STAFF MEMBERS THAT WILL BE OPERATING FROM HOME

Key staff members who will operate from their homes to ensure that operations continue, includes the following:-

- EXCO members with the exception of HOD.
- Other MANCO members not mentioned in any of critical and essential services:
- All Deputy Directors and officials on OSD who are on an equivalent level to DD's.

### 5) PROVISION OF IT SUPPORT REQUIRED DURING LOCKDOWN

- Install team software to enable the remote engagement of crisis management team as well as project management personnel;
- Provision of extra data to all key staff members that will be operating from home;
- Co-ordination of help desk support by IT;

### 6) COMMUNICATION WITH STAFF, CLIENTS AND SUPPLIERS

- KZN DARD website will remain operational to disseminate information.
- Only communication unit is allowed to engage media on any matter that might arise during lockdown
- The possibility of creating units' whatsapp groups to aid engagement will be explored. Currently EXCO and MANCO whatsapp group is in place.
- Use of print media and translation of such into IsiZulu as a dominating language in KZN.
