

## UNVEILING OF THE STATUE OF AMAZULU KING SHAKA

KZN Agriculture MEC Madlopha-Mthethwa was part of the momentous and historic occasion at the King Shaka International Airport in La Mercy, north of Durban, where the statue of the erstwhile AmaZulu King Shaka was unveiled.

The international airport was named after the AmaZulu King who reigned from 1816 to 1828.
