

AGRIC MEC KAMADLOPHA-MTHETHWA PLEDGES TO IMPLEMENT BENCHMARKING LESSONS

The Inter-Provincial Benchmarking Programme held in Germiston, Gauteng on 24 September 2024 between the KwaZulu-Natal and Gauteng Provincial Governments was led by Premiers - Thamsanqa Ntuli and Panyaza Lesufi, respectively. Accompanying the KZN Premier was the Executive Council Members, Director Generals, Heads of Department and Senior Officials.
