## KZNDARD OPENS A WINDOW OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY FOR COMMUNAL FARMERS 05 December 2015

One of the main objectives of the Agrarian Reform and Transformation strategy is for agriculture to become a science and a business. This is exactly what transpired at Enyokeni Royal Palace in Nongoma. His Majesty, the King Goodwill Zwelithini in partnership with KZNDARD, held **the first ever Farmer's day and livestock auction focusing on a special** breed of indigenous cattle, the Boran.

Over 118 cattle were auctioned including 16 thoroughbred Boran, 30 crossbreeds and about 60 Nguni cows. A total of 74 of His Majesty's cattle went under the hammer leaving just a little under 44 left.

The participation, mostly by communal farmers, proved to be pivotal in instilling the culture of economic participation in the sector. Such programmes are used as tools for the introduction of the Genetic Livestock Improvement programme, which will see indigenous breeds like the Boran being introduced to communities to bring a competitive edge to communal farmers for an enhanced economic participation.

MEC Cyril Xaba urged farmers in the Province to participate in these kinds of activities and said that such events are information sharing sessions where the gap between the emerging and commercial sector will be closed. This event was declared by the MEC to be an annual event for farmers throughout the Province to participate in.
