Event One: Invitation to a dinner: handover of Financial Compensation to 15 Indian families in Durban affected by the Group Areas Act

The restoration of land rights is forging ahead in KwaZulu-Natal with 15 eThekwini families set to receive financial compensation for the land they lost as a result of forced removals under the Group Areas Act. The families opted for financial compensation.

The Hounorable Premier of KZN MR Senzo Mchunu together with the KZN MEC for Agriculture and Rural Development, Mr Cyril Xaba, will be formally announcing the settlement for the claims, which amounts to a substantial amount of money and will also be interacting with the families at an event to mark the occasion.

The media is invited to cover this historic gathering to showcase the work being done by the KwaZulu-Natal Land Claims Commission and to tell the stories of the successful claimants.

province will be handing over the title deeds to a farm in the Ugu

District to land claimants who have been successfully farming their

land.

In 2013, the Minister of Rural Development and Land Reform Mr

Gugile Nkwinti approved the settlement of the Insika Yamabombo

Community Land Claim, benefitting 150 households.

The community opted to farm the 545 hectares that had been

restored to them. The land is predominantly under sugar cane and

the beneficiaries are being assisted by Illovo Sugar as a mentor in
