

KZN AGRICULTURAL SECTOR WELCOMES THE NEW VISION FOR AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE PROVINCE

THE MEC for Agriculture and Rural Development in KwaZulu-Natal, Mr Cyril Xaba, convened a special meeting with commercial commodity organisations in the agricultural sector.

MEC Xaba used the meeting to present his new vision for agricultural and rural Development in the Province. At the heart of the vision, is working in cooperation with other government departments, organized agriculture and local communities to grow agriculture as a major driver of the provincial economy.
