uThungulu District Municipality has been one of the worst affected by drought in the Province and the emerging sugarcane sector is bearing the brunt the most. To date, the KZN Department of Agriculture and Rural Development with the assistance of the Department of Rural Development and Land Reform, has spent over R140 million on the emerging sugarcane sector. These funds have been pivotal in the implementation of Ratoon management and other agricultural aspects of the sugarcane sector.
