

KZN DARD LAUNCHES MOBILE LODGEMENT BUS IN ULUNDI

The MEC for KZN Agriculture and Rural Development Cyril Xaba as the Champion for Rural Development in the Province, together with the Commission on Restitution of Land Rights, which is a wing of the Department of Rural Development and Land Reform, officially launched the Mobile Lodgement Bus in Ulundi in Northern KZN.

The Mobile land Claims Lodgement Bus is being shared between KwaZulu-Natal and the Eastern Cape on a three month basis. It started on its rounds in August last year in KwaZulu-Natal and after three months, it went to the Eastern Cape. The mobile office is back in our province until 10 February 2016 and residents in Ulundi will be able to Lodge their Claims.
