


LAND PREPARATION



TAKE A SOIL SAMPLE TO DETERMINE LIME AND FERTILIZER

REQUIREMENTS (EVERY THIRD YEAR)

MINIMUM OF 20 CORES








PUT SAMPLE IN BOX AND SEND TO CEDARA



IF RECOMMENDED APPLY LIME ACCORDING TO SOIL **ANALYSIS, 1 - 3 MONTHS BEFORE PLANTING**








READY TO PLANT

PLOUGH OR DEEP **WORK SOIL WITH A** FORK OR SPADE



NEVER PLANT POTATOES EVERY YEAR IN THE SAME PLACE; PRACTICE CROP ROTATION



FIRST YEAR: FERTILIZE ACCORDING TO SOIL TEST, AFTER LIME HAS BEEN APPLIED






APPLY LAN AT START OF FLOWERING

ONE 500ml TIN LAN / 15m







FERTILIZATION SECOND AND THIRD YEARS AFTER SOIL TESTING















AT START OF FLOWERING, APPLY LAN: ONE 500ml TIN / 15m OF ROW



USE GOVERNMENT CERTIFIED SEED




ORDER SEED POTATOES IN MAY OR JUNE


CULTIVARS TO BE USED:

- Astrid......5 months to harvest.
- Mnandi...... 5 months to harvest.

PLANT WELL SPROUTED TUBERS IN FURROWS 20-30cm APART






SMALL TUBERS; 20CM APART

MEDIUM TO LARGE TUBERS; 30CM APART




COVER TUBERS WITH SOIL AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO PREVENT SUNBURN (ROTTING)






DO NOT PLANT POTATOES IN THE SAME PLACE EVERY YEAR: PRACTICE CROP ROTATION




PLANT GOVERNMENT CERTIFIED SEED,

DISEASE IDENTIFICATION



EARLY BLIGHT

CIRCULAR OR ANGULAR LESIONS WITH A YELLOW BORDER, OCCUR AFTER WARM MOIST CONDITIONS.



LATE BLIGHT

WATER-SOAKED DARK AREAS ON LEAVES, OCCUR AFTER MOIST WEATHER



VIRUS INFECTION

DWARFED PLANTS WITH YELLOW OR LEATHERY LEAVES



HARVESTING



TO HARVEST - USE A FORK OR SINGLE FURROW PLOUGH TO LIFT POTATOES

- DO NOT LEAVE POTATOES LYING IN THE SUN








WAIT FOR 2 WEEKS
