


Vaccinate YOUR DOG AND CAT

WHAT IS RABIES?

Rabies is a disease that affects the brain and leads to the death of the person or animal involved.

Symptoms vary widely and may include:

- Behavioural changes
- Aggression
- Salivation
- Paralysis

RABIES AFFECTS ALL ANIMALS!

Spreading of the disease

The virus occurs in great numbers in the saliva of rabid animals.

CONTACT YOUR VET OR ANIMAL HEALTH TECHNICIAN

How to control Rabies?

- Vaccination is the only protection.
- Vaccinate your dogs and cats.
- Encourage other people to have their pets vaccinated too.
- Do not allow your pet to roam the streets.
- Report all suspect cases to your nearest state veterinarian, animal health technician or to the police.
