MEC Super Zuma has served in various structures of the African National Congress, Local Government, Labour Unions, and the Legislature. He was deployed as the Deputy Mayor for the Hilton Transitional Local Council (1996-2000).

As a member of the National Education, Health and Allied Workers Union (NEHAWU), he has served in various union structures and later became the Provincial Secretary from 2001 to 2008.

In the African National Congress, Moses Mabhida Region, he served in the following positions: **Deputy Regional Secretary** from 2006 to 2008; **Regional Secretary** from 2008 to 2014; **Regional Chairperson** from 2014 to 2015. At the African National Congress provincial Level, he was elected as the KZN Provincial Secretary from 2015 to 2018. He currently serves as the Provincial Executive Committee member as well as in the Provincial Working Committee of the ANC in KwaZulu-Natal and chairs the Disciplinary Committee.

He joined the KwaZulu-Natal Legislature from 2018 to 2019 and served as the Deputy Chief Whip. After the 2019 National General Elections, he was appointed as the KwaZulu-Natal Legislature Chief Whip (2019- 2023), wherein he was the Chairperson of the Whips Forum. At the Legislature, he has served in various Portfolio Committees, including Agriculture and Rural Development, Public Works, Economic Development and Tourism, Transport and the Standing Committee on Oversight (STACOV).

He has since been appointed as the MEC for Agriculture and Rural Development (February 2023).
