### SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICE PROVIDERS:

**Service providers must ensure that they are fully aware of all the conditions listed below. Only service providers that fully meet these conditions will be considered:**

- a) Service providers must submit the following certificates and permits as mandated by the National Environmental Management Waste Act (NEMWA No 59 of 2008) and the associated Waste Regulations with its prescribed Norms and Standards:
  - Waste Management License
  - SAWIS registration
  - Atmospheric Emission Licence (replacing APPA certificate)
  - Storage Licence
  - SANS 17025 Accreditation
  - ISO 14001
  - OHSAS 18001
  - ISO 9001
  - Responsible Care Commitment (CAIA (Chemical and Allied Industries Association))
  - SQAS Certificate – KZN
  - CIDB Certificate
- b) It is mandatory that service providers are fully capable of processing mercury chemicals and mercury waste (holders of the above certification and permits should however qualify).
- c) Chemical waste requiring disposal, from all sites in the Department, excluding the Makhathini Research station will be transported by Departmental personnel to an area designated for temporary, chemical waste storage at the Head office: Cedara.
- d) Chemical waste requiring disposal at the Makhathini research station could not be quantified due to OHS concerns. The service provider must visit this site, with the correct PPE and equipment, as required by law, to cost the disposal of waste there, and then include this in the final quotation. It will also be the responsibility of the service provider to travel to this site, collect and uplift receptacles containing hazardous chemical waste. – (Contact Mr Johan van Rensburg in this respect: 084 583 9617)
- e) Service providers must provide a report detailing: classification of unknown hazardous substances and mixtures according to their physical, health and chemical properties; processes used to treat and dispose of all hazardous waste; and location of disposal site/s where applicable.

- f) In addition to the above, proof of formal disposal at an accredited waste disposal site must also be supplied.
- g) Service providers must provide a 30-day notice period for date of collection and removal of waste from the designated, waste storage area at Head office: Cedara and Makhathini research station.

A site visit to any of the sections at Cedara or the research stations around KZN can be arranged, should the service provide require it. Images taken of the storage room housing the chemical requiring disposal at the Mkhathini research station are available, and can be shared with the service provider to assist with waste quantification and costing.

- (d) **“Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act”** means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (e) **“EME”** means an Exempted Micro Enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (f) **“functionality”** means the ability of a tenderer to provide goods or services in accordance with specifications as set out in the tender documents.
- (g) **“prices”** includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
- (h) **“proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor”** means:
  - 1) B-BBEE Status level certificate issued by an authorized body or person;
  - 2) A sworn affidavit as prescribed by the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice;
  - 3) Any other requirement prescribed in terms of the B-BBEE Act;
- (i) **“QSE”** means a qualifying small business enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (j) **“rand value”** means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;

## 3. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

### 3.1 THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:
