This Standard Bidding Document (SBD) must form part of all bids invited. It contains general information and serves as a declaration form for local content (local production and local content are used interchangeably).

 - (b) the bidder falls to declare that the Local Content Declaration Templates (Annex C, D and E) have been audited and certified as correct.

2. Definitions
