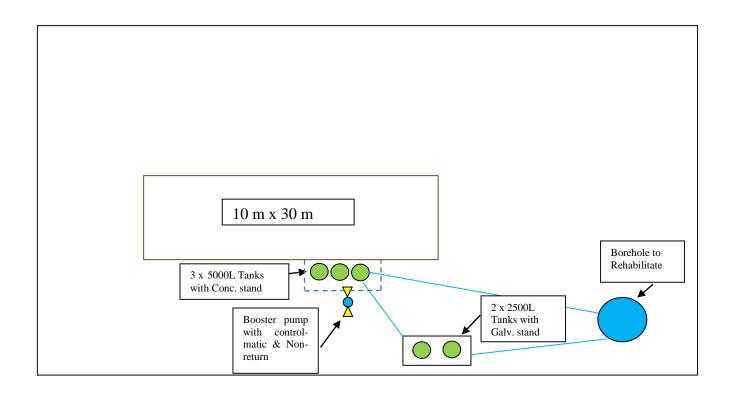

BACKGROUND

10% retention will be withheld on payment for the construction phases. The Department will pay this back as part of the 5th payment, at **practical completion** of the works, whilst the remaining 5% retention will be paid at final completion (6th payment).

11) SERVICE LEVEL AGREEMENT

The successful bidder and the Department will sign a Service Level Agreement prior to commencement of works.

12) SITE FACILITIES AVAILABLE

- 12.1 WATER AND SERVICES. The Contractor shall make the necessary arrangements for the provision of water and services required at the contractors own cost. For unskilled work, the assistance of community members can be utilized at the contractor's costs and all negotiations with the community members will be the contractor's responsibility and not the Department's. The contractor will **not** be permitted to employ local skilled labour. He shall provide his own skilled labour.
- 12.2 LOCATION OF CAMP. The Contractor's camp may be erected on the site of the works. No persons other than a night watchman may sleep in the camp without the approval of the school principal.

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- 12.3 HOUSING OF CONTRACTOR'S EMPLOYEES. No housing is available for the Contractor's employees and the Contractor shall make his own arrangement for housing his employees and transporting them to and from the site. However, it may be possible to arrange temporary local accommodation for the contractor's staff with the nearby local assistance (Like Hall, crèche or houses of project participants etc.). The Contractor is in all respects responsible for the housing and transporting of his employees, and for the arrangement thereof, and no extension of time due to any delays resulting from this, will be granted.
- 12.4 SAFETY. All safety measures including the provision of the Machinery and Occupational Safety Act (Act 6 of 1983) are to be adhered to.

13) DELIVERY OF MATERIALS

Work must be started **within two weeks** of receiving an official order, unless the Department indicates that delivery within this period is not desirable due to delays in the project.

14) ABNORMAL RAINFALL

The Contractor shall keep daily rainfall records and submit it to the Department's representative at every site meeting. No additional payment shall be made for the supply and installation of the rain gauge or for the keeping of the rainfall records and all costs must be included in the scheduled items.

15) 'AS BUILT' DETAILS

As the work progresses, the Contractor shall keep full records of all amendments to and deviations from the specifications as issued to the Contractor at the start of the contract. These details will, where appropriate, be noted on the supplied drawing. No alterations may be made without the written approval of the Regional Engineer.

16) PROGRAMME

The work is to be completed within 3 months of the award of the bid. The contractor is to supply a work schedule with the proposed times of completion of each phase (as per above Payment Schedule) and associated progress payment request for the project. A maximum of seven (7) progress payments can be made.

17) COMPLETION

The tunnels must be fully functional on completion. The contractor will remain responsible for the tunnels including all materials, installations and equipment until the official hand over of the tunnels to the beneficiaries. The hand over and final payment will not take place until such time that the entire structure is fully functional and all defects/ oversights have been attended to.

18) COMPETENCY OF THE CONTRACTOR

The Bidder will be required to satisfy the Department that a sufficiently experienced skilled and semi-skilled **labour force** is employed or that sufficient experienced labour can be acquired to complete the services and produce a fair quality of workmanship. **The Bidder will be required to submit a list of references/projects (ANNEXURE A: References)** to enable the Department to inspect previously completed work and assess the capacity of the Bidder.

The Bidder should have a minimum CIDB grading of 1 SH/CE.

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B) PROJECT TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

1 GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This contract covers the supply, erection and equipping of **One (1)** greenhouse tunnel (10m \times 30.0m), including the supply and installation of horticultural materials and equipment and **1** \times **6** single rows micro drip irrigation system with mixing/storage tank serving the tunnel.

2 ACCESS TO SITE

The site is situated in <u>Umlalazi Local Municipality</u> by <u>Vuma Reserve Area</u>, at <u>King Cetshwayo District</u>. <u>Co-ordinates S 28°50′18.8"</u>, <u>E 31°22′47.3"</u> You will be notified of the exact location during the bid briefing.

3 CHARACTER OF STRATA AND MATERIALS ON SITE

No geotechnical data is available for the site. The contractor must satisfy himself as to the nature of the existing ground conditions.

4 DETAILED SCOPE OF WORKS

The contract includes the following construction work:

- (a) Levelling of site to a uniform longitudinal slope of 1.0 2.0%;
- (b) The supply, erection and equipping of 1 dome shaped greenhouse tunnels with Luminance THB Polythene greenhouse sheeting. Tunnel dimensions: 10m (w) x 30.0m (l)x 4.5m (h).
- (c) Supply of a 3x 5000L storage tank + 2x 2500L Storage tanks (galvanised stand), plus pump, ball valve and fittings;
- (d) Construction of one tank stand, 2.95m x 2.15m x 0.7m (0.5m above ground) with a concrete slab on M150 block walls on strip foundation;
- (e) The supply and installation of horticultural material and equipment for all tunnels. See paragraphs 7.2, 8.2 and 8.3 and Drawing 1 (TYPICAL TUNNEL).
- (f) The supply and installation of a micro irrigation system in one tunnel as per the specifications of paragraphs 9.1 and 9.2 and Annexure C.
- (g) Connection of internal irrigation lay out of the tunnel to the tanks.
- (h) Any other installations/connections required to bring the system into working order.

5 APPLICABLE STANDARDISED SPECIFICATIONS

For the purpose of this Contract the relevant SABS specifications shall apply. All materials to be SABS approved.

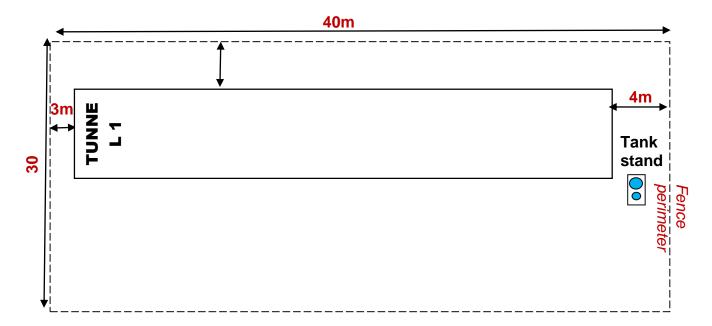

Figure 1: Site plan showing the 1x tunnel and location of the tank stands & changes can be expected in terms of size depending on site conditions and possible positioning



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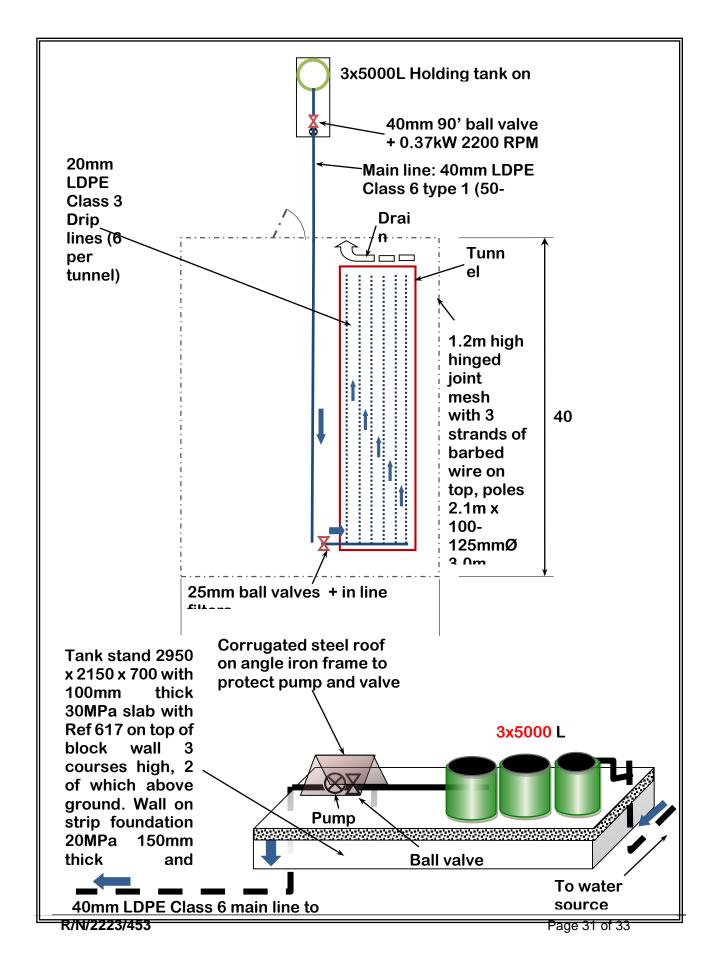

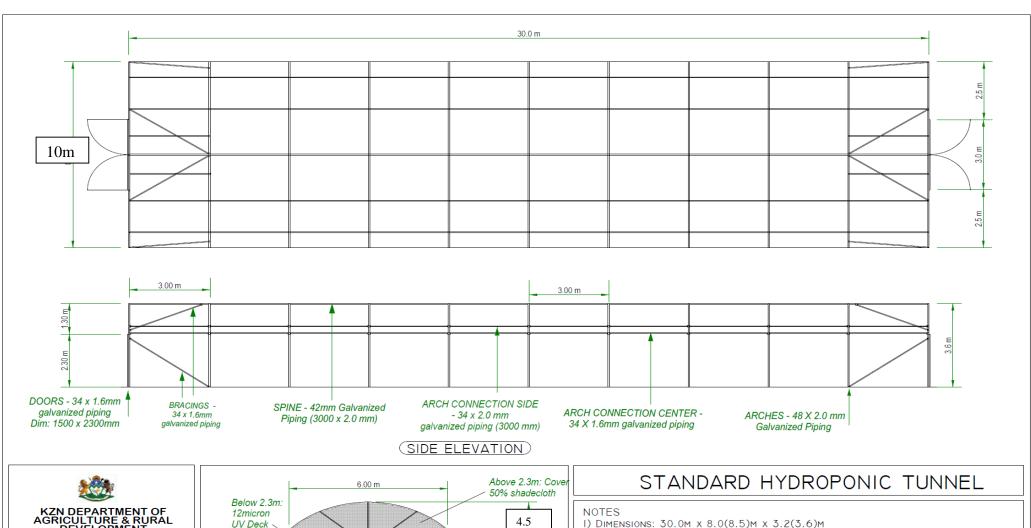

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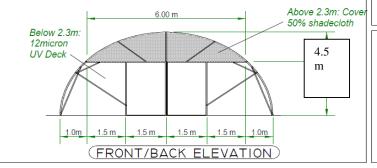
