ADA BURSARIES FOR MSc AGRIC TENABLE AT UKZN

(TWO BURSARIES: 2018)

The Agribusiness Development Agency (ADA) seeks to sponsor the post graduate study with the Master of Science in Agriculture discipline. The funding shall be tenable at UKZN for the 2018 academic year.

The purpose of the bursary scheme is to create future South African agribusiness capacity and to address industry research needs.

If you meet the criteria (in the attached "Information for applicant" document) please apply.

The Agribusiness Development Agency (ADA) administers the scheme via its Bursary Working Committee who will liaise closely with the tertiary institution and the relevant Head of Department and/or Supervisor under whose guidance the student will conduct the post graduate study (Masters).

An application form is attached, (see annexure 1) and you are requested to study this document before completion and submission to the ADA Bursary Working Committee. Confirmation of receipt will be issued by the Administration office.

Applicants must (a) complete the application form in detail, (b) note that only full time students can apply, (c) they must be South African Citizens and (d) A student may hold other bursaries, but a list of those applied for and awarded must be declared, the student should be less than 35 years of age at the time of application.

Preference shall be given to MSc Agricultural Economics and MSc Agribusiness as well as previously disadvantaged individuals.

Information on pages one to eleven should be typed.

Closing date for applications is 26 February 2018.

The Bursary Working Committee will not accept any late applications.
