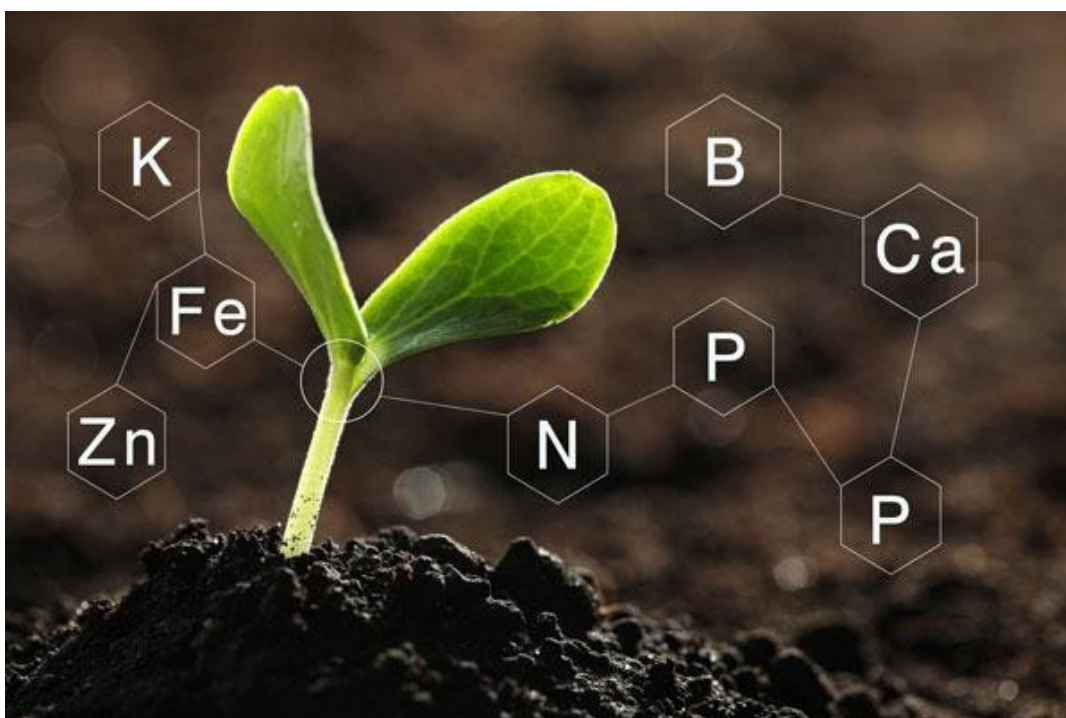
ADVANCED SOIL FERTILITY

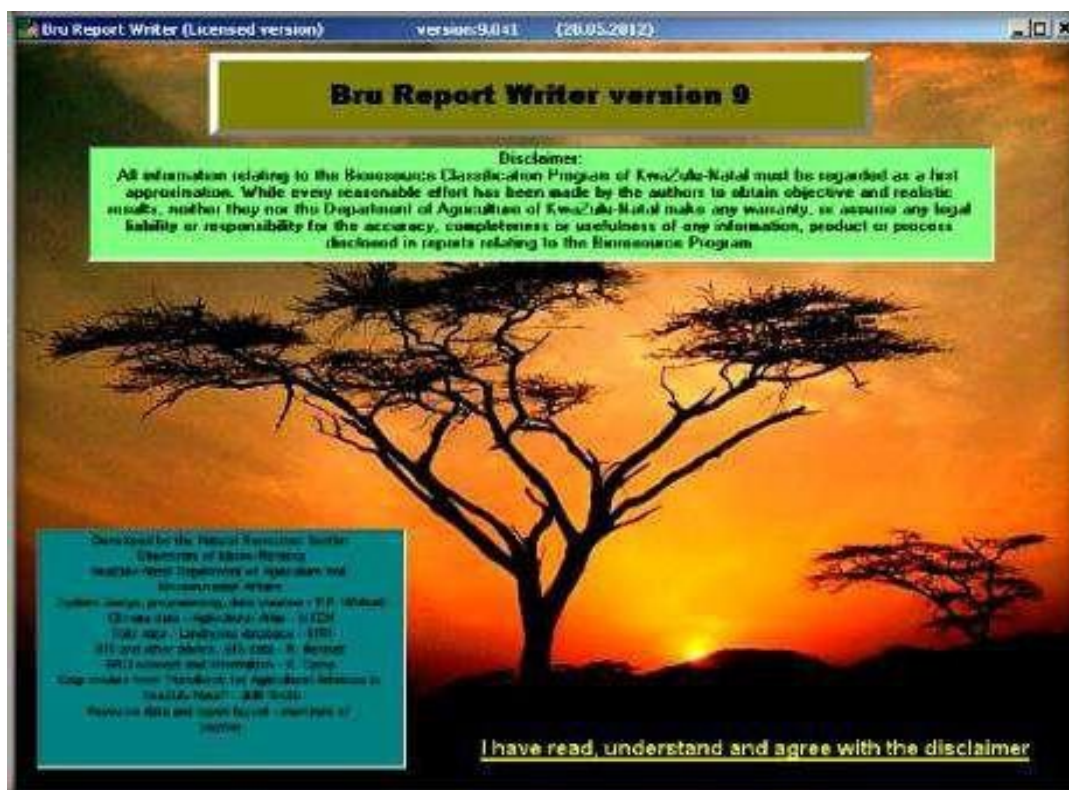

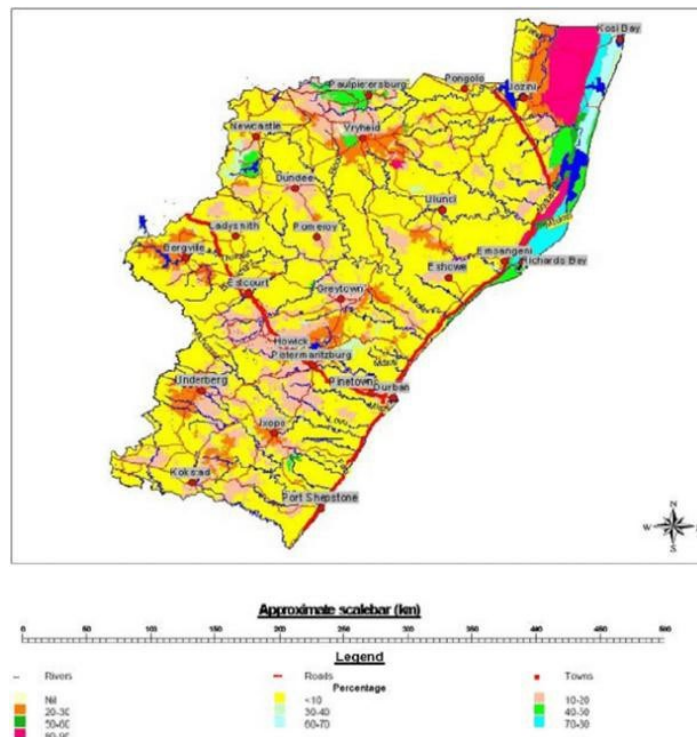

Agricultural finance refers to financial services ranging from short-, medium- and long-term loans, to leasing, to crop and livestock insurance, covering the entire agricultural value chain - input supply, production and distribution, wholesaling, processing and marketing. Agriculture is a major source of livelihood throughout the world, especially for the majority of poor people living in rural areas in developing countries. A key challenge for the majority of these farmers is - access to finance. Lack of access to finance is a key impediment to farmers in improving the efficiency of their productions and adopting better technologies. Small scale farmers and commercial farmers continue to struggle in accessing the finance they need to maintain a sustainable and productive level of output. Small scale farmers which require loans to buy inputs, such as seeds and fertilizers, are often required to borrow against collateral such as real estate, which they simply do not have. As a result, they are unable to fertilize their land and are forced to use seeds held back from the preceding harvest to plant their new crop. These seeds are poor in quality and have degenerated over time and, combined with ineffective fertilization and application of insecticides, leads to decreasing yields and poor quality crops.

This course would mainly cover the following aspects:

Linking farmers to insurance companies.

The outcomes of the course will be:

- Gained an exposure to various finance packages of finance to support the agro processing enterprises
- Create a favourable environment for the agro processors to deliver its business prosperity
- Opportunity for networking with active players in the finance field
- Confidence towards business sustainability and consistency.

The course will encompass an ecological study of the veld, including how to identify grass and tree species. This course also covers the interaction of grazers and browsers on vegetation, veld condition assessments, calculating grazing capacity and stocking rate from these results and also addresses the Principles of veld management. The final day will be spent in doing practical exercises in the field. Please bring suitable clothes and shoes for the field. It is recommended that course participants bring the books; “Guide to Grasses of Southern Africa” by Frits van Oudtshoorn and “Trees of Natal” by Elsa Pooley if possible.

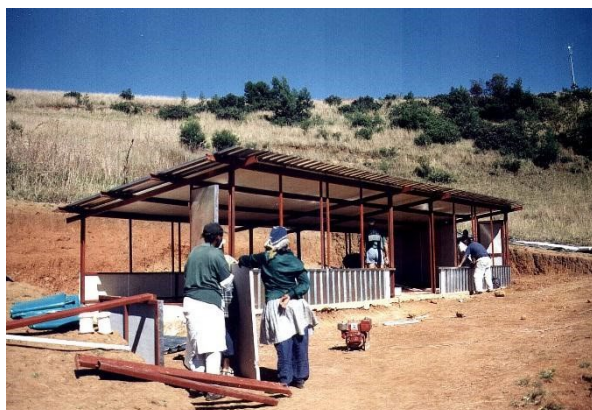

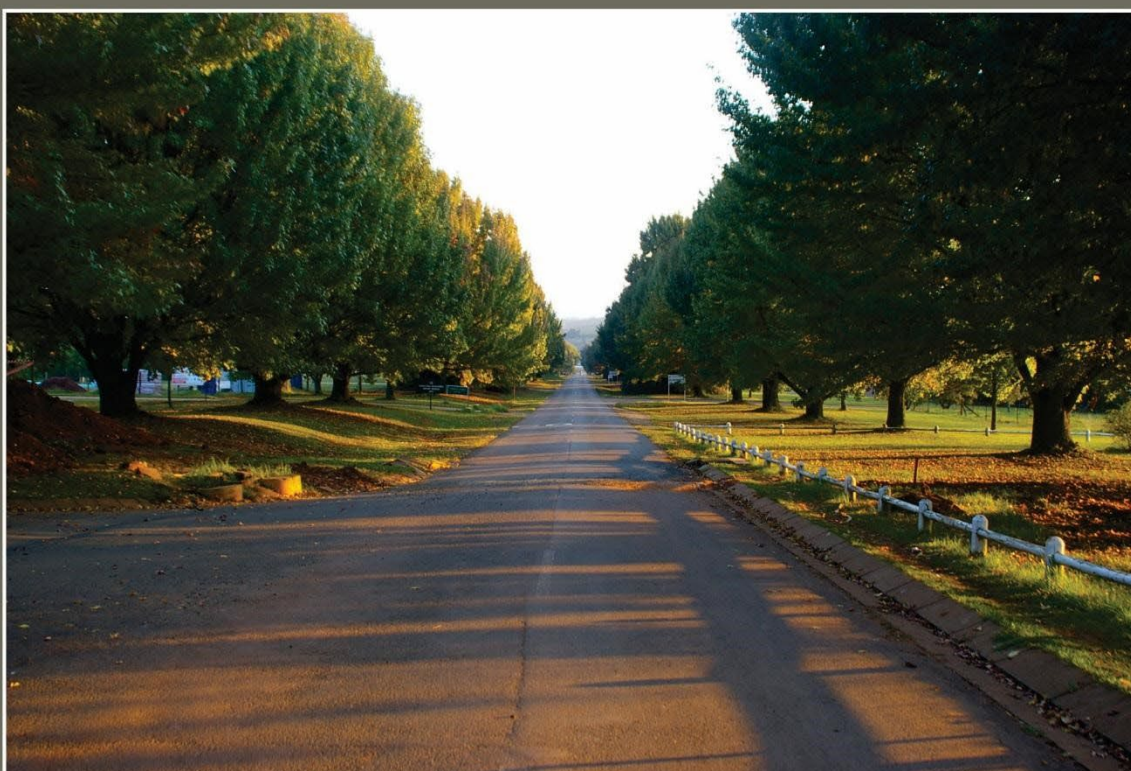
